INTRODUCTION

This statement is made in accordance to the Modern Slavery Act 2015. At Contractor Corner Accounting Ltd we are committed to understanding the risks associated with modern slavery and human trafficking and recognise the need to eliminate all forced and compulsory labour.

SUPPLY CHAINS

Our clients use employment agencies and clients to source their assignments. We all share a joint responsibility to be committed in ensuring there is no modern slavery in our supply chain. Due diligence checks are performed along with pre-employment checks for all workers. We have a zero tolerance approach and will not knowingly work with any business involved in modern slavery or human trafficking.

TRAINING AND AWARENESS

Training is provided to all staff members including senior managers and directors. Any concern relating to modern slavery and human trafficking can be reported to a member of the management team and will be protected in line with the whistleblowing policy.

This statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and is in relation to our financial year ending April 2020.
